

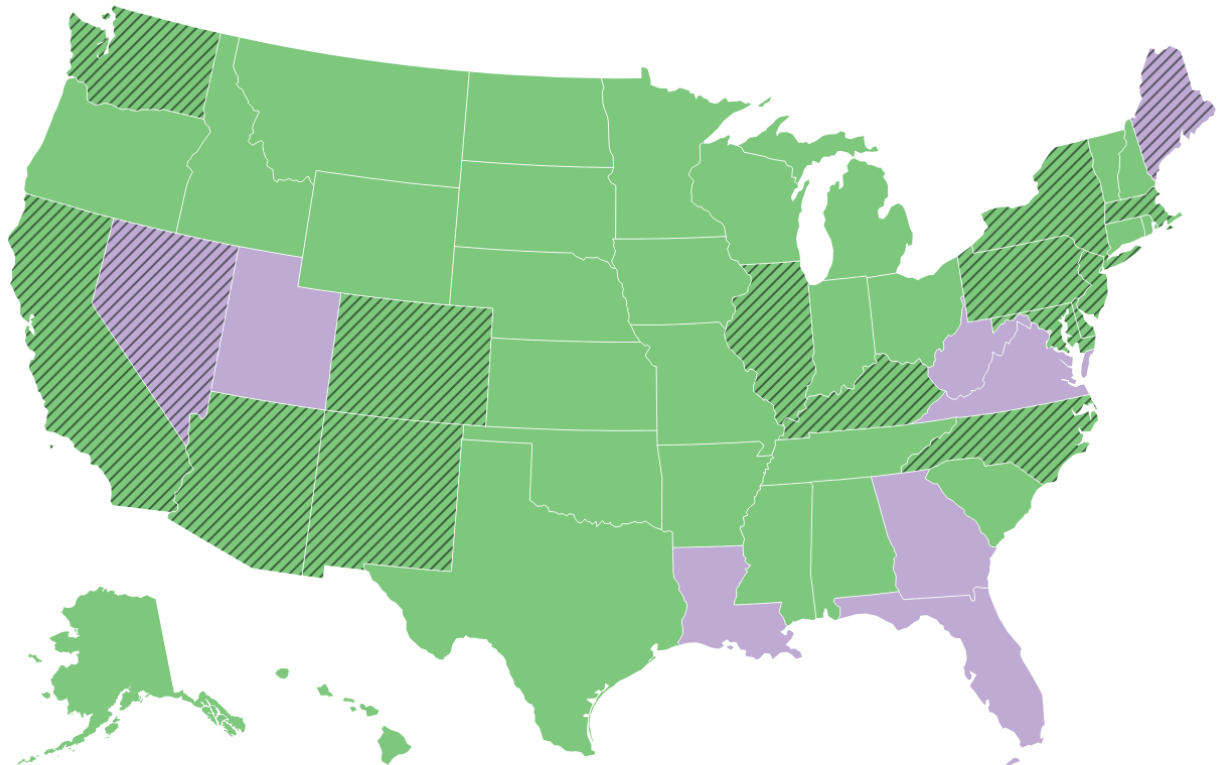
2025-2026 COVID-19 Vaccine Availability, by State
