

## Statement on Supporting Vaccine Recommendations from Leading Medical Societies

September 17, 2025

The Common Health Coalition strongly supports the science-based <u>respiratory vaccine</u> <u>recommendations</u> set forth by national medical societies, including those recently published by <u>AAFP</u>, <u>AAP</u>, and <u>ACOG</u>. These clinical recommendations are rooted in the <u>latest evidence</u>, which demonstrates these vaccines are safe and effective.

Vaccination remains the best way to protect against respiratory viruses like the flu, RSV, and COVID-19 – and their potentially serious complications – and to ensure that children grow up safe from other preventable diseases such as Hepatitis B, measles and pertussis (whooping cough).

We also commend <u>AHIP</u> and <u>ACHP</u>, founding members of the Coalition, for their recent statements affirming continued coverage of vaccines with no cost sharing. Together, we can ensure patients and communities have the access to these life-saving vaccines that they deserve.
